




Embedding Your YouTube Video into Blackboard

This guide assumes you have a YouTube channel (account) and that you have already uploaded your video to YouTube. For information about these steps, see our Quick Guide *Uploading Your Videos to YouTube and Embedding Them in Blackboard* [on our website](#).

<p><u>Step 1</u></p> <p>Go to the content area in your Blackboard course site where you would like to embed the video (e.g. Announcements, a discussion forum, or a weekly folder).</p> <p>Create a new item (or discussion post, etc.) and enter a title. In the text editor toolbar, click on the “Record from Webcam” button on the lower left.</p>	
<p><u>Step 2</u></p> <p>A pop up window will open. Click either link and follow the prompts to sign in to your YouTube account.</p>	
<p><u>Step 3</u></p> <p>Click on the “Browse” tab on top of the pop-up window. All videos uploaded to your YouTube channel will be listed here. Choose the video you’d like to embed and click “Insert.”</p> <p>Note: You can also preview the video before inserting.</p>	

Step 4

Choose how you would like the video to appear on the course page:

- “Play in Place” will allow users to play the video within the course page, right where you post it.


Important: always set width to about 400-500 pixels, otherwise the video will appear too small to watch.

- “Thumbnail” will display a small image of the video on the page. When clicked by users the video will open to play in a new window.

(Your choice depends on how much space you would like the video to take up on the page or post.)

Click “Insert” when done. The video frame or thumbnail will be displayed in the text editor window.

Add a title and enter any additional instructions you want to add. Then, click “Submit” to embed the video into your course site or post.



Choose between an embedded video or thumbnail, and click "Insert."
